The transition to web-based enrollment and Call notification significantly lessens our environmental footprint.

During its 26 years of supporting growth initiatives in the JPD,

Chalice Lighters have funded grants to more than 50 societies totaling over \$2.25 million.

Chalice Keepers, the JPD endowment fund, works with Chalice
Lighters to provide a permanent
financial resource for growth.


Congregations are encouraged to recruit a "Chalice Lighter Ambassador" to organize a Chalice Lighter Sunday every year.
